- Equipment provided to the FBO for mowing and snow removals are provided by the County and probably needs replaced.
- Major upgrades of maintenance like runway/taxiway crackfill and sealing are completed under contract and usually through the grant program. The County has approximately \$15,000 to \$20,000 per year in grant matches. An additional \$5,000.00 - \$7,000.00 per year in basic maintenance cost with no improvements.
 - New structures for private use, such as hangers and shades are handled through land leases with the individuals.
- The approximate income revenues for the airport are \$14,000.00 to \$16,000.00 per year if all of the hangers remain rented and the fuel sales are normal.
- The City would be facing a potential \$20,000 loss per year or more.
- The only resource available at this time to stimulate revenues from the airport is through land leases.
- Would Cochise County and the City if Willcox, be interested in entering into some type of Airport joint venture?
